**Juror:** Matt Schenk, Professor at Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University.

**Deadline:** Monday, November 30.

**Entry Fee:** The entry Fee is \$15 for one entry and \$25 for two. Fill out the entry form on the next page and send it by mail along with a check made out to Grand Valley Artists to Kathy Bechtel, 8418 Golfside Drive, Jenison, MI 49428.

**Cash Prizes:** Cash prizes will be awarded by mail. Matt Schenk will receive the images and will make a decision prior to our Holiday Zoom Party at 7 p.m. on December 10.

We will also create a **Printed Magazine** featuring all of the entries. A magazine will be given to all who participate. It will also be provided electronically to all members so it can be shared with others easily whether they are in GVA or not. Prices will be included in the magazine.
